He started his service as an investigation officer in the Investigation Bureau of the Polish Border Guard Headquarters and continued his service in analytical units of the Intelligence and Investigation Department of the Polish Border Guard Headquarters, the Strategic Analyses Bureau of the Polish Border Guard Headquarters and the Commander-in-Chief of the Polish Border Guard's Office both on executive and managerial positions (Head of Unit and Deputy Director). From 15 September 2016 until 14 March 2018 he served on the position of Director of the Bureau of International Affairs of the Polish Border Guard Headquarters.

In the years 2008-2010, as a national representative, he participated in the works of EU Council group CIREFI (Centre for Information, Discussion and Exchange on the Crossing of Frontiers and Immigration).

In the years 2011-2013 he managed the Team established by Commander-in-Chief of the Polish Border Guard in order to develop a concept of implementation in the Polish Border Guard of the European Border Surveillance System (EUROSUR).
